



Silhouette fabric ink

1



Cut a design in the stencil vinyl using the regular vinyl settings in the Silhouette software. Be sure to leave room around the design to protect your project.

2



Using a Silhouette hook, carefully remove the inside of the design creating a stencil.

3



Apply the clear transfer tape to the design and burnish it. Then peel the transfer tape with your design attached off the vinyl liner.

4



Apply the stencil and transfer tape to your fabric project and burnish the design onto the fabric.

5



Carefully remove the clear transfer tape leaving the vinyl stencil on the fabric.

6



Using the foam brush or sponge, apply Silhouette ink to the fabric. The foam brush fills more of the design, while the sponge gives a more distressed look. Light ink requires two coats when printed on dark fabric.

7



After the ink dries, remove the stencil vinyl.

8



Iron the design to set the ink it into the fabric.

Silhouette fabric ink is machine washable.
